RAMADAN LIVE

Snapshots from our global field offices during the third week of Ramadan.

During the third and final week of Ramadan, Human Appeal has been making the most of your mercy around the world, feeding families across nine countries and supporting children and those who have lost their homes. These are just a few of the ways your mercy has been delivered:



In **Afghanistan**, we distributed **118** food parcels and **7,400** hot Iftar meals in Kabul, which is facing serious concerns with food security.



In **Syria**, we distributed **1,848** food parcels in the village of Al Zohoor, and the displacement camps of Mustafa, Qinnasrin, Zahrat al-Shamal and Maidan Ghazal.



In **Gaza**, we distributed **304** food parcels in collaboration with the Gaza Community Development Group.



In **Lebanon**, we distributed **400** food parcels, **222** hot iftar meals and gave **5** Syrian children cash vouchers across Arsal, Beqaa and Dar Salam.



In **Bangladesh**, our partners in Odhikar have been providing **95** street children with hot meals each day, for a total of **950** hot meals in the last 10 days, and **2,850** over the month of Ramadan.



In **Yemen**, we distributed **218** food parcels and provided Zakat Al Fitr to **400** thalassemia patients.



In **Nigeria**, we distributed food packs to people who suffered from the famine and the cost of living crisis.



In **Somalia**, we provided **600** children with Ramadan packs, provided food parcels to **620** families and 25kg bags of rice to **113** families as a Zakat-al-Fitr distribution.



In **Pakistan**, the country director joined the team on the ground to distribute **168** food parcels to families in Pakistan - in total, Human Appeal has distributed **1,100** food packs across Pakistan.



At home in the **UK**, Human Appeal's amazing volunteers and the staff at Palmer's Green Mosque in London packed 200 food parcels as part of the "Iftar for All Initiative" with Hellman's.



















YOUR MERCY IS HELPING A PAKISTANI WIDOW AND HER CHILDREN FLOURISH

Bibi Shaheen has been providing and caring for six children on her own ever since her husband passed away six years ago. Though she had no regular source of income, she kept her children in education.

Human Appeal supports Bibi and her children via the orphan sponsorship programme, which has helped to keep the children in school and the family able to provide for themselves.

However, they still regularly face shortages of food, and during Ramadan the children ask for good food for iftar, which Bibi is not always able to provide. That is why Human Appeal provided the family with a food parcel during Ramadan that would keep them nourished throughout the whole month, letting them enjoy good, nutritious iftars during the holy month.

YOUR MERCY IS HELPING CHILDREN IN SYRIA

In the final days of Ramadan, the Human Appeal team in Syria celebrated iftar with the children of Al Zohoor village - a village established by Human Appeal which now provides shelter to a thousand families that were affected by the earthquakes in northwest Syria.

The team decorated the houses with Ramadan decorations for the children to enjoy, and shared suhoor with the Qazmouz family, including eight-year-old Ghazal and six-year-old Bayan. After suhoor, the family and the team all prayed together.

Ghazal and Bayan shared what they thought of the village with the team, talking about how preferable it was to living in tents in the displacement camp. Our team was happy to hear it, and glad to have helped ease the lives of these young children.




YOUR MERCY IS BUILDING HOMES IN PAKISTAN

The village of Ghulam Hussain Chandio in Sindh, Pakistan, was one of many villages that was struck by the floods in Pakistan in 2022. The majority of the housing in the village was destroyed, leaving the residents without proper shelter. Instead, they now must sleep in tents, with limited heating and sanitation.

Human Appeal Pakistan has begun a project to build 140 houses in Ghulam Hussain Chandio, to help give the residents the shelter they deserve. The first phase of the construction work has already begun in the blessed month of Ramadan.

Your mercy is helping to change the world, and give Pakistani families who have lost their homes a place to rest their heads, and reassure them that they can rebuild with our support and mercy.





YOUR MERCY IS HELPING TO REBUILD LIVES IN PAKISTAN

Ameer Ali and his wife lived in Ghulam Hussain Chandio, a village in the district of Qambar Shahdakot, in the Sindh, Pakistan. They have nine children, several of whom live with disabilities, who must now live in a tent, after the flooding in Pakistan destroyed their home.

Ameer and his wife need to fetch water, feed their children, and handle household chores - it takes up all their time and funds. Affording a new house while taking care of their family is nearly impossible, even though a house would make taking care of their family so much easier.

But Human Appeal Pakistan has just begun a project to build **140** houses for the families in Ghulam Hussain Chandio, to give them a home after their losses. Ameer and his family will soon have a new house that will help restore comfort to their lives. Thank you for your mercy.
