GAZA EMERGENCY

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HUMANITARIAN SITUATION



- **Formal famine declared in August; 640,000 people (1/3 of population) in famine-level hunger.**
- **Sharp increase in starvation-related deaths, especially children.**
- **Food access blocked by crossing closures, movement restrictions, and unaffordable prices.**
- **Healthcare collapse: most hospitals damaged/destroyed, staff working without supplies.**
- **Clean water below emergency levels; sanitation breakdown causing disease outbreaks.**
- **Over 1 million displaced in unsafe, deteriorating shelters exposed to harsh conditions.**

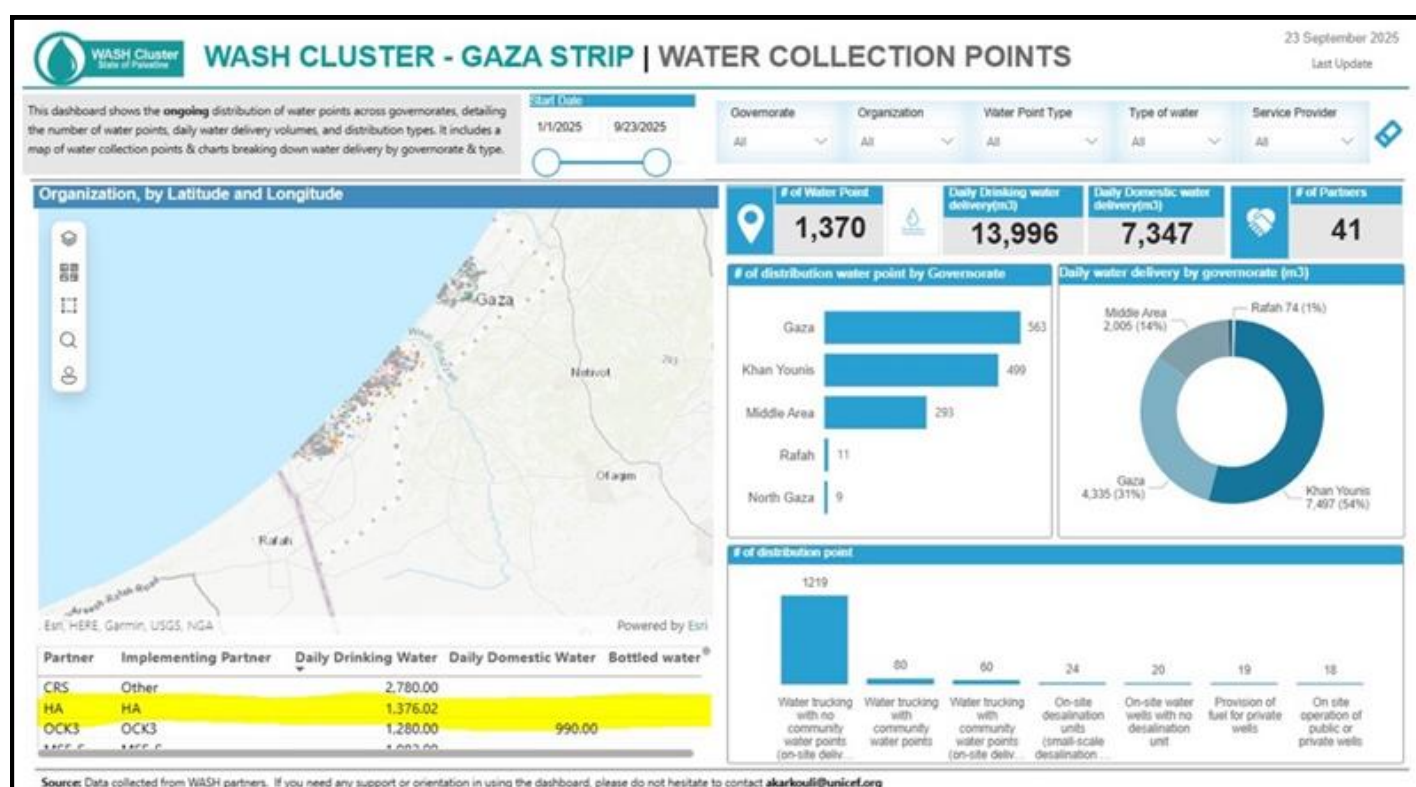
UN News | Hundreds of Palestinian families continued to flee Gaza City via the overcrowded coastal Al Rashid Road, amid a severe shortage of transportation and soaring travel costs.

ACHIEVEMENTS

IN SEPTEMBER



- HA reached **8 Million Hot Meals** distributed since start of emergency.
- HA **Clean Water Distribution** interventions were recognized in the latest cluster report, where we ranked **2nd** among all organizations providing clean drinking water in Gaza.
- Despite evacuation orders in **North Gaza** and severe access constraints, our teams continue to deliver **hot meals and clean drinking water and Makeshift clinics**.
- In September, HA distributed **676,000 hot meals**, including **156,000 meals** in **North Gaza**.
- HA distributed **20,325,000 liters of clean water**, of which **1,685,000 liters** were delivered in **North Gaza**.
- HA also provided **480 units of powdered milk** to support the nutritional needs of **infants and young children**.

HA ranked 2nd in WASH Cluster report for Sep in Gaza.





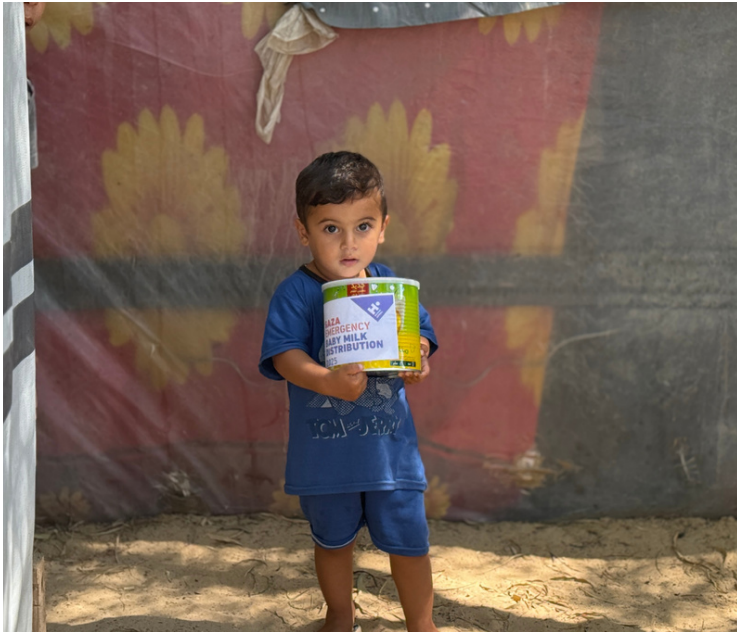
